THE THOUGHTS OF MAN

In my studies this week, looking again at the majesty and worth of God, I was reminded that we all, one day, will stand before the judgment bar of God and answer to God for the sins we have committed. This is why the gospel is so important – through the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross, we can be forgiven and be able to live with God throughout eternity. We must realize that it is not God’s will “*that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance*” (2 Peter 3:8-10). Hebrews 8:12 states, “*For I will be merciful toward their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more.*”

Our thoughts effect our body physically, emotionally, and spiritually; hence, we need to think on good things, especially the promises of God. Do you spend time in the word of God? To get rid of the “stinking thinking” that the world throws at us, we must concentrate on God.

Sin starts in the thoughts of men. We see sin so much in mass media that it does not even bother us anymore. Men try to justify wrongdoing in many ways, and, if not forgiven, they will have to give an answer to the Creator as to why they acted on their thoughts. - Proverbs 23:7 “As a man thinks in his heart, so is he. . . .”
- Isaiah 26:3 “You will keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you.”
- Isaiah 43:18 “Remember not the former things, nor consider the things of old.”
- Psalms 19:14 “Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer.”
- Psalms 94:11 “The Lord—knows the thoughts of man, that they are but a breath.”
- Psalm 139:23-24 “Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!”
- Proverbs 3:5 “Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding.”
- Proverbs 4:23 “Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life.”
- Proverbs 17:22 “A joyful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones.”
- Matthew 6:25 “Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing?”
- Matthew 22:37 “And he said to him, ‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’”
